



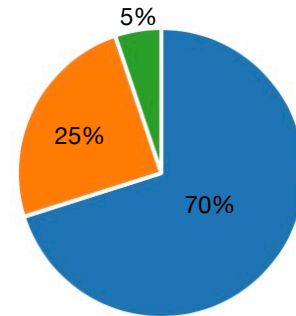

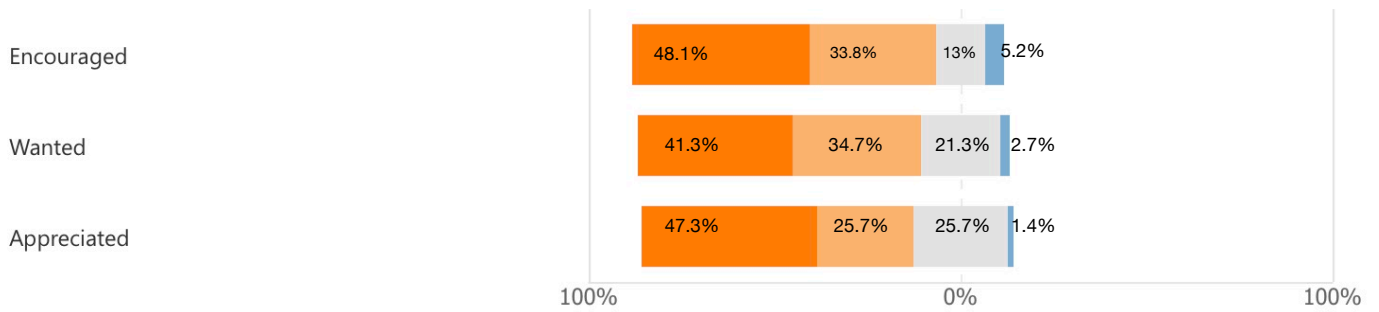

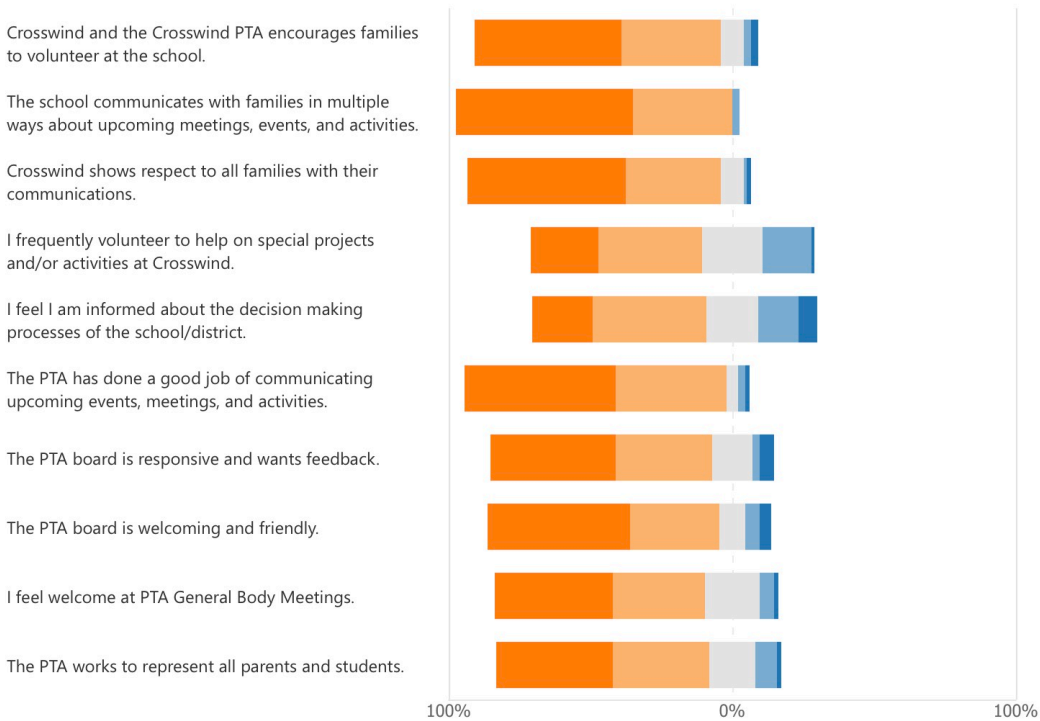
2. When I walk into the Crosswind building, I feel...

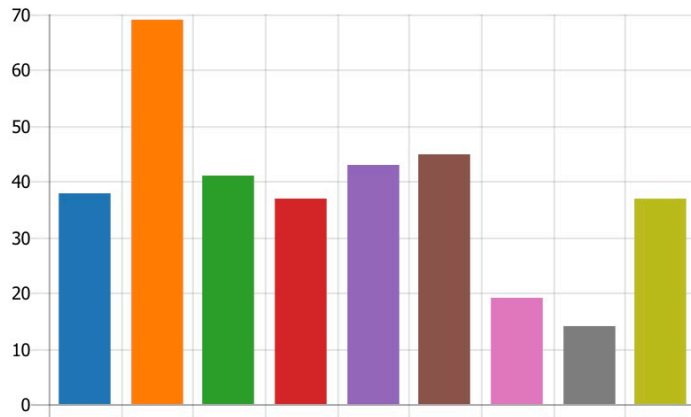

- More communication about how to volunteer for various PTA events/activities

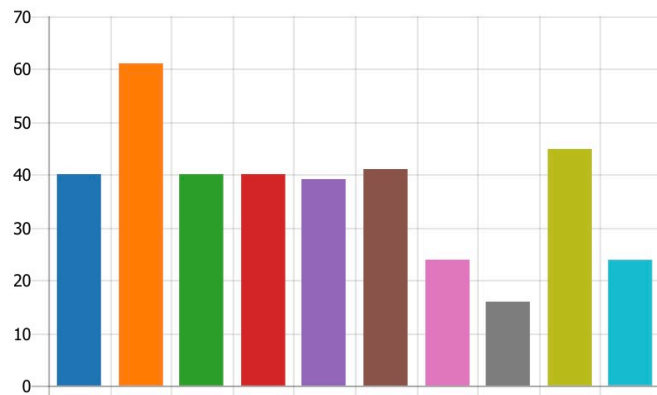

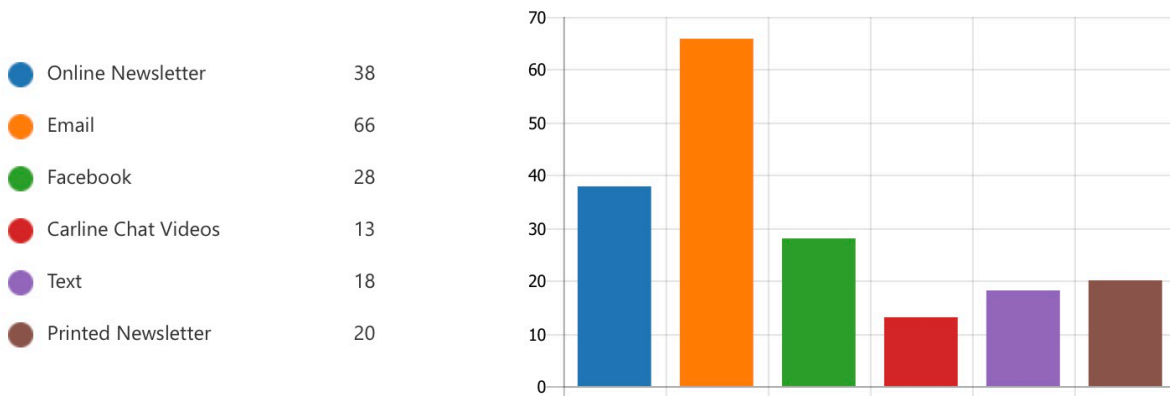
