New for 2020/21

This year we are really seeing the **room parent as a communication resource and coordinator**. Since so many of our usual activities will be done virtually or without a physical presence in the school building, we will rely on room parents to help promote various PTA events, collect needed material, help plan and coordinate activities, etc.

The room parents WILL NOT be collecting class funds this year up front.

This is as a result of our current pandemic circumstance and at the request of Ms. Murin. Instead, room parents will ask for donations as each event approaches, and a coordinated plan between teachers, parents, and administration is in place. It is left up to the discretion of the room parent whether to request a monetary donation or a donation of needed items for each event. Please be mindful of financial hardships some families might be under when asking for any donation.

Because of the health and safety guidelines that restrict large gatherings, PTA is planning programs that reflect a stronger emphasis on facilitating school/family partnerships and community building. To that end, we have scheduled **monthly family involvement events** that include take-home/drive-thru pick-up enrichment activities that are paired with live Teams calls or pre-recorded videos. Our aim is to provide something fun that will help connect students and families and provide an opportunity for sharing and interacting. A schedule of events for the first semester is included below for your reference. A second semester schedule of events will be released as we get closer and are able to evaluate all guidelines in place at that time. Donut Hutt will give 20% toward PTA if you mention Crosswind. Hours of operation are 5 am to 11am. Pre-orders can be made the day before (this is highly encouraged!) and PTA will receive 25%. Students will receive 3 paper plane designs, and colored paper w/instructions will be sent home. Pilot Kandy and Pilot Greg will do 2 live Teams meeting to talk to the children about "all things planes," and kids can also ask questions. 	You CANNOT bring: balloons, homemade food items, hanging decorations from the ceiling, birthday	
	treats to share with the class at lunch time

Teacher Treats

Box Top Collections

Crosswind collects traditional box tops in October and February. These Box Tops clips are being phased out of production, but may continue to be found on many products throughout the store. You can still clip and send them to school. Every valid Box Tops clip is worth 10¢ for our school. Room parents or a designated person communicate to parents to send these Box Tops in and collect them twice a year for our teacher representative. The new Box Tops way of collecting allows you to simply scan your store receipt with the Box Tops mobile app to identify participating products and instantly add cash to your school's earnings online. Teacher Gifts

Beautification Committee:

This is a group of volunteers committed to helping keep the gardens at Crosswind looking their best. Dates are TBD and Ms. Murin would like to schedule to meet quarterly (Aug - May) to work to weed the gardens, trim bushes, etc.

Reflections Art Program:

The Reflections Arts program celebrates arts education, creativity and student achievement. The theme for this year's contest is "I Matter Because."

- <u>Reflections Art Program Committee-</u> A small committee of 4-6 people is needed to help facilitate spreading the word about the contest, improving participation, and providing support with the application and submission process. Committee members will work with the Cultural Arts Chairperson.
- <u>Reflections Art Program Judges-</u> A small committee of 4-6 people is needed to review the submissions and decide on finalists.

Committee on Nominations and Leadership Development:

The PTA will begin seeking volunteers for the Committee on Nominations and Leadership Development (CNLD) in mid-January/ early February. This committee is comprised of 2 Executive Committee members, 2 General Body members, and 1 Faculty member. The objective of this committee is to nominate candidates to fill each officer's position on the PTA Board of Managers. The committee publicly solicits candidates from the general body and confers with candidates about their willingness to serve. This committee's role is vital to the PTA, as they will recommend to the general body the slate of nominees for the Election meeting.

<u>Publicity Committee:</u> assist the VP Publicity in producing a PTA newsletter, help design social media posts and other communication flyers.

Ways and Means Committee: assist VP Ways & Means with soliciting donations from business and community sponsors.

Programs Committee: assist VP Programs in planning content/speakers for each general body meeting

<u>Safety & Citizenship Committee</u>: assist chairperson in planning and promoting Safety Poster Contest, Citizenship Literature Program, Red Ribbon Week.

<u>Hospitality Committee</u>: help chairperson plan and coordinate PTA programs/receptions related to staff support (Back-to-School Teacher Breakfast, Monthly Teacher Treats, Teacher Appreciation week, conference night refreshments, etc.).

<u>Family Involvement Committee</u>: help chairperson plan and coordinate various school-wide events that promote family engagement and community building, including such things as Eagle Family Fun Fest, Donuts with Grownups, Pastries and Pajamas, and/or monthly family involvement events.

<u>Community Outreach Committee:</u> help chairperson coordinate various philanthropic programs, including our monthly food bank donations, Warm Wishes boxes to town employees and PTA sponsors, etc.

Reading Programs Committee: help chairperson work with the school librarian to promote school reading initiatives and coordinate Vote Me In event.

<u>Legislative Committee:</u> help chairperson stay informed about all local, state and national legislation that affects the health, safety, education and welfare of our children and youth.

<u>Turkey Trot Committee:</u> assist Fundraising chair and Race Coordinator with planning/organizing the TT pep rally, race day event, and awards ceremony, to include researching incentives/prizes, shirt designs, etc.
