

Batman Pumpkin Painting Instructions

Step 1: Get all of your supplies out of your kit. You'll need your pumpkin, Paint Brush, Sponge Brush, Paper Plate, Paper Towel, and the cup included in the kit.

Step 2: Fill your cup halfway with water.

Step 3: Pour about a dime sized amount of black paint on your paper plate.



Step 4: Using your sponge brush, paint your pumpkin black.

Step 5: Rinse your sponge brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 6: Let your pumpkin dry for 1 hour.

Step 7: After your black paint has dried, pour about a dime sized amount of yellow paint on your paper plate. Make sure you pour it far enough from the black paint so they won't mix together.

Step 8: Pull your sticky batman logo template off the paper. Place your batman logo on the pumpkin. If you have to re-adjust it that is ok! If it pulls a little of the black paint off that is ok, too! We can touch up the paint later.



Step 9: Once your sticky batman logo template is on your pumpkin, use your paint brush and lightly paint yellow paint around the template.

Step 10: Gently remove the batman logo template from the pumpkin. If it pulls off a little of the dried paint that is ok! We can fix it later! Remember to lay your template on a paper towel or put directly in the garbage can -- We don't want paint all over!



Step 11: With your yellow paint, fill in the rest of the batman logo.

Step 12: Let the yellow paint dry for about 30 minutes. Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.



Step 13: After the yellow paint has dried, check to see it needs another coat of yellow. If so, go ahead and do a second coat of paint on the yellow batman logo. If you do a second coat of yellow, don't forget to rinse your paint brush off and let the paint dry for about 30 minutes.

Step 14: Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 15: If you need to touch up any areas where the batman logo template pulled paint up, go ahead and touch up. Don't forget to rinse your brush off.



Step 16: Let your pumpkin dry. After your pumpkin is dry, feel free to post a picture on our Facebook page Crosswind Elementary PTA to show us your masterpiece! We can't wait to see your awesome pumpkin!!
