

Captain America Pumpkin Painting Instructions

Step 1: Get all of your supplies out of your kit. You'll need your pumpkin, Paint Brush, Sponge Brush, Paper Plate, Paper Towel, and the cup included in the kit.

Step 2: Fill your cup halfway with water.

Step 3: Pour about a dime sized amount of white paint on your paper plate. If you have a white pumpkin skip to Step 7.

Step 4: Using your sponge brush, paint your pumpkin white.

Step 5: Rinse your sponge brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 6: Let your pumpkin dry for 1 hour.



Step 7: After your white paint has dried, pour about a dime sized amount of blue paint on your paper plate. Make sure you pour it far enough from the white paint so they won't mix together.

Step 8: Pull your sticky Circle 1 (smallest) template off the paper. Place circle 1 on the center of the pumpkin. If you have to re-adjust it that is ok! If it pulls a little of the white paint off that is ok, too! We can touch up the paint later.

Step 9: Once your circle 1 template is on your pumpkin, use your paint brush and lightly paint blue paint around the template.

Step 10: Gently remove the circle 1 template from the pumpkin. If it pulls off a little of the dried paint that is ok! We can fix it later! Remember to lay your template on a paper towel or put directly in the garbage can -- We don't want paint all over!

Step 11: With your blue paint, fill in the rest of the circle.

Step 12: Let the blue paint dry for about 30 minutes. Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.



Step 13: After the blue paint has dried, pour a dime sized amount of red paint on your paper plate. Make sure to pour it far enough from the blue and white paint so they don't mix together.

Step 14: Pull your sticky Circle 2 template off the paper. Place circle 2 on the center of the pumpkin. If you have to re-adjust it that is ok! .

Step 15: Once your circle 2 template is on your pumpkin, use your paint brush and lightly paint red paint around the template. Be careful not to paint completely over your blue circle.



Step 16: Gently remove the circle 2 template from the pumpkin. If it pulls off a little of the dried paint that is ok! We can fix it later! Remember to lay your template on a paper towel or put directly in the garbage can -- We don't want paint all over!

Step 17: Fill in with your red paint. Try to paint to the edge of your blue circle, don't paint over the the blue circle.

Step 18: Let the red paint dry for about 30 minutes. Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 19: After the red paint has dried, Pull your sticky Circle 3 template off the paper. Place circle 1 on the center of the pumpkin. If you have to re-adjust it that is ok! .



Step 20: Once your circle 3 template is on your pumpkin, use a pencil to lightly trace around the template.

Step 21: Gently remove the circle 3 template from the pumpkin. If it pulls off a little of the dried paint that is ok! We can fix it later!



Step 22: Pull your sticky Circle 4 template off the paper. Place circle 4 centered around the other circles. If you have to re-adjust it that is ok!.

Step 23: Once your circle 2 template is on your pumpkin, use your paint brush and lightly paint red paint around the template. Careful not to paint over the line you drew with your pencil.

Step 24: Gently remove the circle 4 template from the pumpkin. If it pulls off a little of the dried paint that is ok! We can fix it later!



Step 25: Fill in with your red paint. Careful not to Paint over the line you drew with your pencil.

Step 26: Let the red paint dry for about 30 minutes. Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 27: After the red paint has dried, pull your star template off the paper. Place the star template in the center of your blue circle. Then with your paint brush lightly paint white paint around the template.



Step 28: Gently remove the star template from the pumpkin. Then fill in the star with white paint.

Step 29: Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 30: If you need to touch up any areas where the templates pulled paint up, go ahead and touch up. Don't forget to rinse your brush off.



Step 31: Let your pumpkin dry. After your pumpkin is dry, feel free to post a picture on our Facebook page Crosswind Elementary PTA to show us your masterpiece! We can't wait to see your awesome pumpkin!!
