Spiderman Pumpkin Painting Instructions

<u>Step 1:</u> Get all of your supplies out of your kit. You'll need your pumpkin, Paint Brush, Sponge Brush, Paper Plate, Paper Towel, and the cup included in the kit.

Step 2: Fill your cup halfway with water.

Step 3: Pour about a dime sized amount of red paint on your paper plate.




Step 4: Using your sponge brush, paint your pumpkin red.

Step 5: Rinse your sponge brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 6:Let your pumpkin dry for 1 hour.

Step 7: After your red paint has dried, pour about a dime sized amount of white paint on your paper plate. Make sure you pour it far enough from the red paint so they won't mix together.





<u>Step 9:</u> Once your sticky eye templates are on your pumpkin, use your paint brush and lightly paint white paint around the eye templates.



Step 10: Gently remove the eye templates from the pumpkin.

If it pulls off a little of the dried paint that is ok! We can fix it later! Remember to lay your template on a paper towel or put directly in the garbage can -- We don't want paint all over!





Step 11: With your white paint, fill in the rest of the eyes.

Step 12: Let the white paint dry for about 30 minutes.

Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 13: After the white paint has dried, check to see it needs another coat of white. If so, go ahead and do a second coat of paint on the white eyes. If you do a second coat of white, don't forget to rinse your paint brush off and let the paint dry for about 30 minutes.

Step 14: Once the white eyes on your pumpkin are dry, pour a dime sized drop of black paint on your paper plate. Make sure to pour it far enough apart that the colors on your plate don't mix.

Step 15: With your black paint, make your spider web lines.

Be creative here. There is no wrong or right way to draw the lines.

Step 16: Rinse your paint brush off in the cup of water and dab on the paper towel.

Step 17: If you need to touch up any areas where the eye templates pulled paint up, go ahead and touch up. Don't forget to rinse your brush off.
